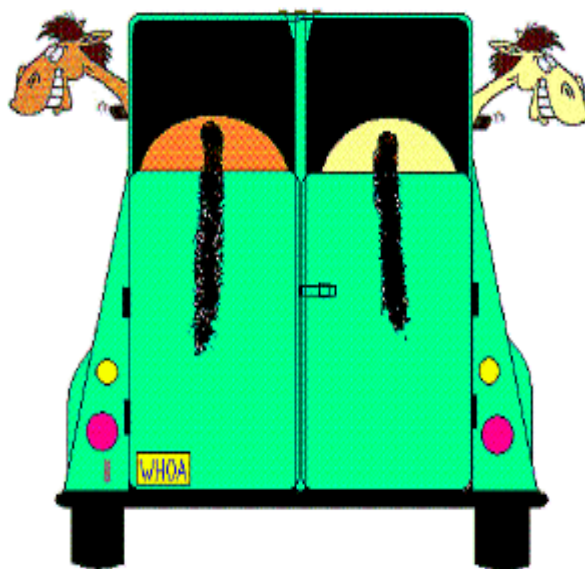

Message from the President

Hi Members,

Are you ready for show season?

With our first show less than two months away, let's all ask ourselves one question, "AM I PREPARED"?

Now is the time to go through your paperwork. Make sure every horse you are going to show in ARHA points classes is registered with ARHA. Have a copy of those papers in hand to turn in at the show office as well as a copy of their current year negative Coggins test. Yes, you could just register them at the first show but why pay a rush fee and why make more work for the office staff?

Did you renew or join ARHA/WRHA? Do you have your membership cards? Remember that to show in ARHA points classes, both you and the owner of the horse (if different) must have a current year ARHA membership and you must be able to show both of those cards at time of entry. Have a copy of them to hand in at the first show along with the registration papers.

In addition to the copies for the show office, keep extra copies in your trailer. Too often we see members rushing around looking for that missing paperwork they swore they had but can't quite remember where it is. Show day is not the time to clean out the truck looking for your documentation.

Bring a blank check to the show office window when you enter. I know most of us are used to paying for things with credit or debit cards these days, but we cannot accept those at the show. You will be asked to leave a signed/blank check with the office when signing up for your classes so don't forget to have one along.

We have a new office manager this year, Rachel Meek. Some of you may know her from running the offices at area Palomino shows. Rachel brings a lot of experience to the table and will be a welcome addition to our show staff. Let's show her we all know our stuff and come prepared!

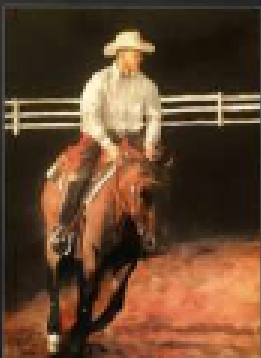

Show Rules/Info:

- Both exhibitor and horse owners must be current year ARHA members and must show proof/copy at time of entry. Bring copies of horses ARHA registration papers OR join ARHA, register and show your horse the same day (bring copies of front & back of breed registry papers). Applicable ARHA fees will apply including \$10.00 rush fee.
- Registry open to all registered western stock type horses (AQHA, APHA, ApHC, IBHA, ABRA, PBHA, PtHA-stock, NQHR, POA*, Appendix and Jockey Club Thoroughbred, Mustangs* (All breeds must meet minimum 13.2hh requirement. Some breeds will require veterinary certification. See ARHA website for further requirements for Mustangs* and POA*)
- Classes 8, 9, 13, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 34, 39, 40, 57, 60, 61, 71, 72 – No ARHA pts therefore no ARHA registration required.
- Exhibitors must show in proper western attire, long sleeve shirt (no crystals, sequins, glitter, or zippered shirts allowed), hat/helmet & jeans in all classes. Working tack for horses. No silver halters.
- No fake tails, banded manes or hoof polish allowed. Judged on natural appearance and movement. Judge's decision is final.
- All classes judged according to ARHA rules.
- Negative 2017 coggins required.
- Out of state horses – WI requires proof of original health certificate.
- All Youth classes are 18 & Under
- ** Class 20, cannot cross enter into any other class.
- Select classes – exhibitor 50 yrs or older.

Year End Awards 2017

Exhibitor must be a current year WRHA member and must show at a minimum of three of the five shows to qualify for any of the following awards.

Class Awards - \$5.00 nomination fee per class.

Awards given to 1st, 2nd & 3rd highest point earners in each class. Must earn at least one point in the class to receive award. Class points will be tabulated based on the following table. Points will be awarded based on class placings only (no additional points for grand or reserve).

Final points total will include all points earned in respective class at the 2017 shows.

Completed nomination form must be submitted and fees paid before earned points from the class begin counting. For example, if you show at the first and second show but did not turn in your form until the morning of the second show, the points earned at the first show will not count towards your year end total.

In the case of a tie, the exhibitor/horse with the highest number of points earned in that class under Judge A at the five WI based shows will be the winner.

Division Hi Point and Reserve Hi Point Year End

No nomination fee - Awarded to the all around highest point earners in each division.

All-Age Division
Youth Division
Select Division

Amateur Division
Novice Amateur Division

Points earned will be determined using the points schedule shown above. Final points total will include all points earned by the horse in the All-Age Division and by the exhibitor/horse combination in Amateur, Novice Amateur, Youth and Select divisions at the WI based shows - **must have exhibited in at least one cattle class in that division at each of the shows for the points from that show to count towards the respective award.**

In the case of a tie, the exhibitor/horse with the highest number of points earned in that class under Judge A at the shows that were included in the total will be the winner.

WRHA Top Cow Horse Award

No nomination fee - **New for 2017 – A Top Cow Horse award will be given in three divisions = All-Age, Amateur and Youth.**

Will be awarded to the horse/rider combination earning the most points in the five cattle classes in each of the three divisions at the five WI based shows. The points from the class # indicated below will be used.

Top Cow Horse All-Age Div = classes 1, 4, 10, 14, and 17.
Top Cow Horse Amateur Div = classes 2, 5, 11, 15 and 18.
Top Cow Horse Youth Div = classes 3, 7, 12, 16 and 19.

Calculation of points and tie breaker will be the same as above.
