# WRHA Awards Program

Exhibitor's **and horse owner's** must be current year WRHA member **in good standing** to be eligible for any awards. **Points will not count toward weekend or yr end awards until Membership fee has been paid.** 

WRHA points follow the ARHA Point Scale for all awards. See ARHA Rule Book Section H-13

### **Division Weekend Highpoint**

Awards given to 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> highest point earners in each Division. Exhibitors **MUST** show in a cattle class in that Division to be eligible.

All Age Division
Amateur Division
Novice Amateur Division
Youth Division
Green as Grass Division

### Year End - Class Awards:

Must show at a minimum of three (3) of the four (4) WRHA shows to qualify for any of the **year end** awards. All age Division, is based on horse, all other division on horse/exhibitor combination. Awards given to 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> highest point earners in each class. Must earn at least one point in the class to receive the award. Points will be awarded based on class placings and any points earned in a Grand or Reserve halter class. (Grand Champion receives 2 points, Reserve Champion receives 1 point).

## **Year End - Division High Point Awards:**

Awards given to 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> highest point earners in each Division. **MUST** show in a cattle class at three (3) of the Four (4) shows in that Division to be eligible.

All Age Division
Amateur Division
Novice Amateur Division
Youth Division
Green as Grass Division

Points total will include all points earned by the horse in the All Age Division and by the exhibitor/horse combination in Amateur, Novice Amateur, Youth and Green as Grass divisions at the WRHA shows.

# **Top Cow Horse Award(TCH):**

Awards given in All Age (horse) and Amateur divisions (horse/Exhibitor) with the highest point totals in all cattle class in those divisions.

#### **Top Performance Horse (TPH): NEW 2023**

Awards given in All Age (horse) and Amateur divisions (horse/Exhibitor) with the highest point totals in all NON-Cattle classes.

**For all Year End awards** - In the case of a tie, the exhibitor/horse with the highest number of points earned in those classes under Judge A at the four WRHA shows will be the winner.
